

SAFETY COMMITMENT

We continue our steadfast focus on safety – for our patients, visitors, physicians and staff. You will find consistent safety measures in place at all of our hospitals and outpatient health centers.



Staff, patient and visitor screening

- Screening includes a series of important questions to determine risk.
- ▼ Temperatures are taken for anyone entering an EEH site.



Physical distancing

- Reminder signage is located throughout sites.
- Appointment times have been spaced, and virtual registration minimizes exposure.



Clean and disinfected facilities

- Facilities are deep-cleaned every day to include exam rooms, waiting areas and staff workstations.
- Patient rooms and bathrooms are thoroughly cleaned between patients and every day.



COVID-19 patient testing prior to procedures

All surgery patients receive a COVID-19 test prior to their procedure.



Restrictions on visitor policy

- Visitors are allowed in inpatient rooms only under special circumstances.
- One companion only may accompany outpatient visits if needed.



Personal protective equipment (PPE)

- All staff are provided with PPE as recommended by the Centers for Disease Control - masks, goggles, gowns, etc.
- All outpatients and visitors receive masks upon entry.



Designated COVID-19 care areas

- Patients with COVID-19 stay in designated inpatient units.
- Patients with suspected COVID-19 stay in designated ER pods.

Emergency Department

It is critical that anyone experiencing a medical emergency come to the Emergency Department as soon as possible. Avoiding care can have serious and long-term implications. The Edward-Elmhurst Health EDs are ready and well-equipped to keep you safe.

- Patients with respiratory symptoms are seen in designated pods.
- Staff wear masks, goggles and safety equipment when needed.
- All patients and visitors are screened and masked upon arrival.
- Patients are registered remotely to limit exposure.
- Extra staff have been assigned to perform hourly cleaning.

Physician Offices

Video visits are available for either new or current patients for a new health issue or follow-up. Or, if you'd like to see a physician in-person, our focus on safety doesn't stop with the hospital facilities.
