




Recommendations by the CDC's Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices

- When a COVID-19 vaccine is authorized by FDA and recommended by ACIP, vaccination in the initial phase of the COVID-19 vaccination program (Phase 1a) should be offered to both:
 - health care personnel, and 1.
 - 2. residents of long-term care facilities.






Phase 1A in Illinois: Initial Doses



Phase 1A in Illinois: Geographic Prioritization










Phase 1A in Illinois: Timing




