
SEXUAL ASSAULT SURVIVOR UNDER THE AGE OF 13 ARRIVES AT AN APPROVED PEDIATRIC HEALTH CARE FACILITY WITHOUT FIRST BEING EXAMINED AT A HOSPITAL

with a complaint of sexual assault within a minimum of the last 7 days or has disclosed past sexual assault by a specific individual and was in the care of that individual within a minimum of the last 7 days.

OR

AN APHCF IS CONTACTED BY LAW ENFORCEMENT OR DCFS REGARDING A SEXUAL ASSAULT SURVIVOR UNDER THE AGE OF 13

with a complaint of sexual assault within a minimum of the last 7 days or has disclosed past sexual assault by a specific individual and was in the care of that individual within a minimum of the last 7 days.



The qualified medical provider will provide medical forensic services.

The patient will be transferred or directed to a Treatment Hospital designated in the APHCF's approved plan in order to receive medical forensic services. The patient may be transported by ambulance, law enforcement or personal vehicle.
